




Would you describe yourself as very prejudiced/a little prejudiced against people of other races? 1983-2013 (including 5 year moving average)
















How has the % who report some level of racial prejudice of each of these demographics changed over time?












Link between racial prejudice and immigration




	Some racial prejudice	No racial prejudice


Same-sex relations can sometimes be wrong
