Pioneers honoured by Top 100 Asian Stars in UK Tech 2019 list

London, June 5 2019: Thirty of Britain's leading tech entrepreneurs were honoured with a Pioneers Award at the Top 100 Asian Stars in UK Tech list launch on Tuesday 4th June 2019. The list celebrates diversity in the digital sector with a focus on disruptive technologies and celebrated its fifth anniversary last night. Among those recognised with a Pioneers Award were Faisal Butt, Founder and CEO of Pi Labs, who has invested in startups like Trussle, the UK's first digital mortgage advisor, and Hubble, an office space marketplace; Shaolan Hsueh, the Founder of virtual language-learning platform, Chineasy; innovation expert, advisor and mentor Bindi Karia and Dharmash Mistry, an entrepreneur, non-executive director and experienced investor, currently General Partner at Lakestar, one of the leading VC firms in Europe, investors in Spotify, Facebook & Airbnb among others.

Dilip Joshi MBE, Chairman of Diversity UK said: "I am delighted that the Top 100 Asian Stars in UK Tech list has celebrated its fifth birthday with a stellar list of nominees and that we have been able to honour the Pioneers who have been appearing on this list since it began.
